

CADI Qualification - November 30th 2015

1. IT WAS RESOLVED THAT:

1.1 Due to the changes in the FEI World Dressage Challenge effective for 2016, the CIEF Board determined it was necessary to amend the eligibility criteria for selection of riders to represent the Cayman Islands at CADI.

1.2 Any rider trying to qualify for CADI [2016] must obtain two Eligible Scores (as defined below).

1.3 Each Eligible Score must be obtained from a Qualifying Show (defined below).

1.4 Only one Eligible Score can be obtained from each Qualifying Show.

1.5 Each Eligible Score must be at least 58%

1.6 At least one of the Eligible Scores must be from the FEI Children's Preliminary A Test (the "CADI Prelim").

1.7 Eligible Scores for CADI must be obtained in the Cayman competition season leading up to the CADI for which qualification is sought. For example for CADI 2016, only scores obtained between 16 June, 2015 and 15th June, 2016] can be Eligible Scores.

1.8 Subject to the above, an 'Eligible Score' is defined as a score from one of the following tests

1.8.1 any USEF First Level (or higher) Test;

1.8.2 any CADI Prelim; or

1.8.3 any FEI Preliminary Test.

1.9 For the avoidance of doubt, Eligible Scores attribute to the rider only and a rider may obtain Eligible Scores on more than one horse.

1.10 The sum of the two Eligible Scores for each rider will represent the Accumulated Score (the "Accumulated Score")

1.11 CIEF will extend invitations to those riders with the highest Accumulated Score in descending order up to the number of riders invited from Cayman to attend CADI.

1.12 If a rider declines the invitation to represent Cayman at CADI, the rider with the next highest Accumulated Score will be invited.

1.13 The following is a list of all "Qualifying Shows":

- a) any CIEF National Dressage Show;
- b) the CEA Dressage Challenge; or
- c) any overseas dressage show judged by an 'r' judge or above.
