

Changes to Qualification Requirements for WDC 2014

1. IT WAS RESOLVED THAT:

1.1 Subject to resolutions 1.2 to 1.5, the qualifying score for the FEI World Dressage Challenge Preliminary Test for 2015 for any horse and rider combination be raised from 55% to 58% obtained at any Qualifying Show;

1.2 Any horse and rider combinations with a score of 55% or more on an FEI Preliminary Test at the National Dressage Show held in October 2013 or January 2014 will qualify for the FEI World Dressage Challenge 2015 on the basis of those scores;

1.3 From 1st October 2013, all qualifying scores will last 18 months before they expire and require a horse and/or rider to requalify;

1.4 Any horse and rider that have each achieved a qualifying score of 62% or more in an FEI Preliminary Test or above in a Qualifying Show, will qualify as a combination in any class for the next FEI World Dressage Challenge provided that such scores were obtained in the 18 months prior to that FEI World Dressage Challenge;

1.5 For clarification purposes, there is no qualifying score required for a horse and rider to enter any class above Preliminary in the FEI World Dressage Challenge but a rider's competency to enter a class must be confirmed by their coach prior to entry in that class.

1.6 The following is a list of all "Qualifying Shows":

a) the CEA Dressage Show;

b) the CIEF's National Dressage Shows;

c) any overseas dressage show judged by an 'r' judge or above;

d) any CIEF show judged by Cindy Thaxton or other qualified person or persons as the CIEF Board of Directors may agree from time to time.
