Directions: To EC: Look for white plank fencing off Linford Pierson Highway on left hand side when heading away from George Town.

Parking of trailers & vehicles: All vehicles including trailers, horse boxes and cars etc. should be parked outside the property in the designated parking area. Permission to park within the show grounds should be made in writing to the Show Manager (subject to availability).

^{*} Order of classes: Please note that this list does not necessarily represent the order of classes.

Age restrictions: Adult and Junior riders are allowed to ride at all heights and will be judged together.

Rules: All competitors must be members of the CIEF for the current show season. All classes will be judged in accordance with the National Jumping Series rules dated July 2018, which are available on the CIEF website at www.ciefcay.com > Downloads > Rules.

Awards/Rosettes: The 0.5 Meter/X-Rail Open Class will be awarded with Clear Round or Participant rosettes. For all other classes, rosettes will be awarded to 8th place. Awards will be

presented following completion of each height level or at the completion of all classes.

SHOW ENTRY

Please note that you must be a current member of the CIEF to enter and must have a current signed liability waiver on file with the CIEF. Please ensure you receive an acknowledgement of receipt if emailing your entry.

How to Enter: Please complete a show entry form (available on the CIEF website: www.ciefcay.com > Events > Prize Lists for Upcoming Shows) and hand deliver to Tracey Surrey at Cayman Riding School or Mary Alberga at The Equestrian Center along with payment confirmation or cheque. Scanned entry forms, along with a Butterfield online payment confirmation may be emailed to the show's respective Show Manager: NJS #1 #2 – Wendy Mannisto caymannis@yahoo.com and NJS #3 Tanya Ziemniak cief.caymandirector2@gmail.com Please ensure you receive an acknowledgement of receipt.

How to pay: Payment may be made by local cheque made payable to the CIEF or online via Butterfield Bank transfer (please attach payment confirmation to entry form.) CASH IS NOT ACCEPTED. Payment must be made prior to a competitor's entry into the arena for the class. Non-payment may result in a competitor being disgualified from the class.

Entry Deadline: Entries for all classes are due by midnight on the Thursday prior to the show date.

Late Entries/Post Entries: We will be allowing riders to enter additional height(s) on the day without having to pay the late entry penalty (\$20) as long as the horse and rider combination have already registered for another height that day. Late entry fees must be paid by cheque on the day or with proof of on-line transfer.

All other late entries to NJS classes will be accepted after the deadline on the day of the show up until the start of the class being entered, with a late fee of \$20 per class.

Refunds and cancelations: No refunds will be allowed after the entry deadline. Rider or horse substitution is allowed in accordance with the NJS rules.

Non-competing horses / Non-competing riders: Non-competing horses and riders may only be mounted at the show grounds with

prior permission of the Show Manager. No visiting horse/riders are allowed to be ridden at the Show Grounds.

Stabling: Visiting horses should contact the show manager to confirm their stabling needs. All visiting horses are asked wherever possible to leave the stalls in the condition they were found.

ORDER OF GO AND WARM UP

Registration: The registration desk will be open on the day of the show from 7.00am. The Order of Go will be posted around the show ground as well as at the registration desk.

Course Walk: There will be two times for the 3 course walks at this show. The course walk for heights from 0.50m to 0.80m will take place at 7:15am. In the interest of saving time, coaches are encouraged to walk the 0.50m course first, so riders in the 0.5m can start warming up right afterwards. The first rider is expected into the arena at 8.00am sharp. The second course walk for classes from 0.90m and above will take place once the course has been set to 0.90m after completion of the 0.80m class and will last for exactly 15 minutes. The first rider for the 0.90m class will be expected into the arena exactly 10 minutes following the completion of the second course walk. Therefore, riders in the 0.90m class need to start their horse warm up before the course walk, and use the 10 minutes following the course walk to finish their warmup.

Competition bridle numbers: Bridle numbers will not be required at this show.

ARENAS AND ACCESS

Main show grounds are made up of two arenas, a Warm Up Arena and a Competition Arena.

Competition Arena – At the EC, the Competition Arena is to be entered and exited from the Warm Up Arena (the regular dressage arena) using the gate furthest from the viewing stand.

Warm Up Arena - to be used for coach-supervised warm up. No more than 4 riders in a class may be actively warming up (jumping) at a time. Other riders in the current class or the following class may be in the Warm Up Arena, subject to the discretion of the Warm Up Ring Steward. Those riders not engaged in active warm up must remain in walk or trot, be respectful, not interfere with and give right of way to those riders engaged in active warm up. Note that riders should pass 'left to left' when approaching another rider.

Lower Warm Up Arena at the EC – May be used only for flat warm up and lunging.

Protective Headgear: All riders MUST wear protective headgear at all times when mounted. Any rider found mounted on a horse without protective headgear risks being eliminated from the show.

GENERAL

Spectator Areas: Spectators may view the show from the bleachers located by the Upper Barn (see map of Show Grounds).

Stabling: Owners of visiting horses should contact the show manager to discuss any specific stabling needs. Visiting horses may tie up to any open tree near the Visitor Stabling area, or use the temporary corrals in the Visitor Stabling area (see map of Show Grounds).

Location of wash bays: There are two wash bays (one by the Upper Barn and by the Lower Barn). Wash bays are available on a first come first served basis. Please refer to map of show grounds for locations. All riders are expected to use their own grooming kits/shampoo etc.

Dogs/pets: All dogs/pets must be kept on a lead/leash.

Bicycles: No bicycles or motorbikes are allowed on the show grounds.

Concessions/bake sale stand: The CIEF operates a bake sale that generally offers water, Gatorade, fruit, snacks and baked goods. The bake sale is generally open from the start until the end of the show. All proceeds are used as CIEF fund raising.

Toilets: At the Equestrian Center, a toilet is located in the upper trailer.

Smoking: Smoking is not permitted anywhere at the show grounds.
