



PRIVACY NOTICE

Introduction

The purpose of this notice is to provide you with information on our use of your personal data in accordance with the Data Protection Law, 2017 (the "DPL").

In this document, "we", "us" and "our" refers to the Cayman Islands Equestrian Federation (the "CIEF").

Member Data

By virtue of you becoming a member of the CIEF and your associated interactions with us (whether past, present or future), including the recording of electronic communications (or phone calls where applicable) or by virtue of you otherwise providing us with personal information, you will provide us with certain personal information which constitutes personal data within the meaning of the DPL ("**Member Data**"). We may also obtain Member Data from other public sources. Member Data includes, without limitation, the following information relating to you: name, residential address, email address, contact details, signature, nationality, place of birth, date of birth, passport number, driver's license number and correspondence records.

In our use of Member Data, the CIEF will be characterised as a "data controller" for the purposes of the DPL. The CIEF's delegates may act as "data processors" for the purposes of the DPL.

Who this Affects

If you are a natural person, this will affect you directly.

How We May Use Your Personal Data

The CIEF, as the data controller, may collect, store and use Member Data for lawful purposes, including, in particular:

- (i) where this is necessary for the performance of our rights and obligations under the constitutional and operational documents of the CIEF;
- (ii) where this is necessary for compliance with a legal and regulatory obligation to which the CIEF is subject; and/or
- (iii) where this is necessary for the purposes of our legitimate interests and such interests are not overridden by your interests, fundamental rights or freedoms.

Should we wish to use Member Data for other specific purposes (including, if applicable, any purpose that requires your consent), we will contact you.

Why We May Transfer Your Personal Data

In certain circumstances we and/or our delegates may be legally obliged to share Member Data and other information with the relevant regulatory authorities.

The Data Protection Measures We Take

Any transfer of Member Data by us or our duly authorised delegates outside of the Cayman Islands shall be in accordance with the requirements of the DPL. We and our duly authorised delegates shall apply appropriate technical and organisational information security measures designed to protect against unauthorised or unlawful processing of Member Data, and against accidental loss or destruction of, or damage to, Member Data. We shall notify you of any Member Data breach that is reasonably likely to result in a risk to the interests, fundamental rights or freedoms of either you or those data subjects to whom the relevant Member Data relates.
