

CIEF STIPEND POLICY

(dtd October 27, 2019)

The CIEF Board will decide, at its sole discretion, when to provide a stipend of whatever size to individuals for attending international competitions or an FEI course for officials.

Development Events: The international competitions for which the CIEF may provide a stipend must be designated by the Board as being important for the development of youth athletes in equestrian sport ("Development Events").

- 1. The following are considered Development Events:
 - a. CADI The Children of the America's Dressage Invitational
 - b. The PAEC Caribbean Junior Jumping Challenge (CJJC) (aka "SCAD")
- 2. The stipend shall total USD 500 (KYD 415) for each athlete competing under the Cayman flag at each Development Event.
- 3. An athlete may compete in more than one Development Event each year, and so may receive more than one stipend each year.
- 4. Stipends are available to participants in Development Events regardless of nationality.
- 5. Stipends shall be paid after the completion of the Development Event.

FEI Courses for Officials: In order to encourage volunteers to attend FEI courses to become officials, the CIEF shall provide a stipend under the following circumstances

- 1. Stipends will be limited to FEI courses for
 - a. Judges
 - b. Stewards
 - c. Course Designers
- 2. Stipends shall only be paid for courses taking place outside of the Cayman Islands
- 3. Stipends shall not be paid for national courses or for FEI courses organized in the Cayman Islands
- 4. The value of the stipend shall total USD 500 each (KYD 415)
- 5. Stipends are restricted to persons who are Caymanian or Permanent Residents of the Cayman Islands.
- Stipends shall be paid only after the successful completion of the course.

FEI Coach Education Courses: Stipends will not be given for Coach Education courses. Those seeking stipends for coach education may apply to the CIOC through the CIEF.
